



ECC Croquet Club Rules

- Only ECC members can join the ECC Croquet Club.
- The cost to belong to the ECC Croquet Club is \$50 per calendar year per person which entitles the member to play unlimited croquet for the year.
- Croquet players, including children, that are non ECC Croquet Club members must pay \$5.00 each time they play.
- The croquet fees are used for: croquet equipment, croquet court maintenance, croquet events and promotion and the ECC Croquet Club's annual membership fee in the United States Croquet Association.
- All croquet players must be ECC members, their minor children or the ECC member's accompanied out-of-town guests.
- Children must be at least 12 years old to play croquet and 18 years old to play unaccompanied by an adult.
- Croquet players must wear all white apparel "Whites" and flat-soled, lawn friendly shoes. Players not wearing all white apparel are not allowed to play. There are no exceptions allowed.
- All croquet players must sign in at the pro shop before playing and pay if not Croquet Club members. Reservations are encouraged.
- Upon the completion of play, the last players on the court should return the balls, mallets and center post to the storage closet, lock the door and return the key to the pro shop and if playing at night, turn off the lights.
